



Prime Minister of Georgia Paid an Official Visit to Brussels

29-30.09.2020, Brussels

Within the framework of the visit, PM Giorgi Gakharia held meeting with NATO Secretary General, Jens Stoltenberg at NATO Headquarters. During the meeting, parties stressed strong dynamic of NATO-Georgia cooperation during recent years - high-level meetings and successful joint exercises confirm NATO's strong support for Georgia's Euro-Atlantic integration.
