Additional localized restrictions imposed due to the epidemiological situation in Georgia:

- ➔ Starting 9 November, pedestrian and transport traffic to be prohibited after 10 p.m. in 7 large cities, save for the stipulated exceptions;
- ➔ All organizations to close at 10 p.m., except for medical, pharmaceutical, and strategically important sites;
- ➔ Both municipal and private kindergartens to be temporarily closed in 7 large cities. [More](#)



U.S. Secretary of State Pompeo to Visit Georgia Next Week

Georgia welcomes U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo's forthcoming visit to Georgia scheduled for 17-18 November. Within the framework of the visit, the Secretary of State will hold meetings with Prime Minister - Giorgi Gakharia, President - Salome Zourabichvili and Minister of Foreign Affairs - David Zalkaliani. Mike Pompeo will also meet with the Catholicos-Patriarch of All Georgia, Ilia II. *"We welcome the visit of the U.S. Secretary of State to Georgia. Statement of the Georgian Side At the OSCE Permanent Council Meeting

11.11.2020

At the OSCE Permanent Council meeting the Co-Chairs of the Geneva International Discussions presented report about the situation on the ground. The Georgian side provided information on security and grave human rights violations at the occupied territories of Georgia. Amb. Tsikhelashvili denounced the meeting between Russian President, Vladimir Putin and de-facto



leader of occupied Abkhazia, Aslan Bzhania in Sochi as further evidence of Russia's continued violation of Georgia's sovereignty and territorial integrity. Tsikhelashvili also spoke of borderisation, illegal detention of Georgian citizens, their ethnic discrimination and gross violation of their rights, as well as the closure of crossing-points restricting the freedom of movement. According to the report, the policy response to Covid-19 went hand in hand with securing support from international partners.
