European Commission Released the Third Association Implementation Report on Georgia

The 3rd Association Implementation Report on Georgia which sets out the state-of-play of Georgia's implementation of its reforms under the EU-Georgia Association Agreement over the past year. The report says that Georgia's Association Agreement commitments, including DCFTA, have been implemented in line with agreed timelines. "Georgia continued consolidating its position as a key partner in the region with its reform efforts and the ambition to further develop its relations with the EU, as highlighted by Georgia's 5-point reform programme" – reads the report. The Grand Chamber of the European Court of Human Rights Orders Russia to Pay €10 Million as a Moral Compensation to Georgian Citizens in the Case of Mass Deportation

The Grand Chamber of the European Court of Human Rights (ECHR) announced its judgment by sixteen votes to one in the case of Georgia v. Russia, regarding the arrest, detention and collective expulsion of Georgian nationals from Russia in the autumn of 2006. The European Court of Human Rights ruled that Russia has to pay 10,000,000 euros to Georgia for non-pecuniary damage suffered by a group of at least 1,500 Georgian nationals. [MORE](#)

- The First round of consultations on strategic partnership and cooperation agreement between Georgia and the UK was held in London, aiming at creating of bilateral legal base for further relationship between the two countries after the UK leaves the EU.
