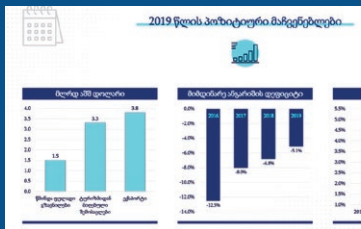

### Foreign Minister of Georgia held phone conversation with his Lithuanian counterpart

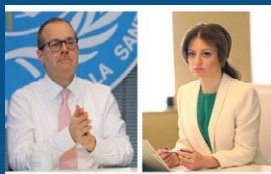
