Interagency Coordination Council Meeting

20.10.2020, Tbilisi

Due to epidemiological situation in the country:

- Restaurants will operate till 22:00 o'clock at the Municipality of Mtskheta;
- From 21 October, if Georgian citizens present negative PCR test results upon entry to the country, they will be subject to self-isolation instead of the mandatory quarantine;
- Air companies will be able to gradually resume regular flights to Amsterdam, Vienna, Warsaw, Athens, Vilnius, Dortmund, Katowice and Milan from November 2020. [More](#)
